

Adolf Hitler has often been compared to Alexander the Great because (a) of the belief that both were bent on world conquest, and because (b) the empire of each lasted but for a short space of time. (Alexander the Great reigned for 12-13 years, dying on June 10, 323 B.C.; Adolf Hitler led Germany for 12 years and 3 months, from January 30, 1933, to his death on April 30, 1945.)

Irving *Berlin* was launched by the song "*Alexander's* Ragtime Band" is because Irving Berlin was prophetically attached to Alexander the Great in Daniel 8:8 through the fact that the Lord ordained his life and death (as we shall see) to be the face of the prophetic understanding that there were *two* (2) *different spirits of Antiochus IV Epiphanes of Daniel 8:9* occurring simultaneously during World War II, and in opposition to one another. There was the spirit of (i) the United States (of Roosevelt/Truman) as the *second* Syria (of Antiochus IV Epiphanes) of the last days and *a competing spirit* of (ii) Adolf Hitler's Nazi Germany in the role of the *second* Syria (of Antiochus IV Epiphanes) of the last days.

Alexander the Great. Here is the *first* Alexander the Great:

Daniel 8:8 (KJV) Therefore <u>THE HE GOAT</u> [Alexander the Great's Grecian Empire] WAXED VERY GREAT [which is why the Lord ordained Alexander to be known to history as 'the Great']: and when he was strong, <u>THE GREAT HORN WAS BROKEN</u> [Alexander the Great's premature death in 323 B.C.]; and for it [from it] came up <u>FOUR NOTABLE</u> ONES [the 4 (four) kingdoms of Ptolemy, Seleucus, Cassander, and Lysimachus] <u>TOWARD</u> THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN.

Hitler's Germany. Here is a *second* Alexander the Great, pointed to by Berlin and Alexander (Irving Berlin and "Alexander's Ragtime Band," Berlin's first hit):

Daniel 8:8 (KJV) Therefore <u>THE HE GOAT</u> [Germany] <u>WAXED VERY GREAT</u>: and when he was strong, <u>THE GREAT HORN WAS BROKEN</u> [Adolf Hitler's suicide on April 30, 1945, and Nazi Germany's surrender on May 7, 1945, ending 12 years of rule]; and for it [from it] came up <u>FOUR NOTABLE ONES</u> [represented by the Four-Power Rule over post-World War II Germany by the United States, Great Britain, France, and the USSR] <u>TOWARD THE FOUR WINDS OF HEAVEN</u>.

The United States. Then comes the United States as the Little Horn that arises out of the Four-Power Rule of post-World War II Germany:

Daniel 8:9 (KJV) And OUT OF ONE OF THEM [the second Syria, the United States]

CAME FORTH A LITTLE HORN, which waxed EXCEEDING GREAT, toward THE

SOUTH, and toward THE EAST [which includes the post-World War II era U.S. victory

over the Soviet Union in the East-West Cold War, which had beginnings wrapped around the Truman Doctrine that helped prevent Greece from falling into the Soviet sphere], and toward THE PLEASANT LAND.
