

Through (i) the 1943 wartime musical *This is the Army*, Irving Berlin and Ronald Reagan were linked together in the World War II defeat of Nazi Germany, and through (ii) the November 9-11, 1989, event of the fall of the Berlin Wall, Ronald Reagan and Irving Berlin were linked together in the Cold War defeat of the Soviet Union.

Irving Berlin and Ronald Reagan

Through the 1943 wartime musical *This is the Army*, *Irving Berlin and Ronald Reagan were linked together in the World War II defeat of Nazi Germany*. Berlin wrote the story and original music for the movie and even appeared in the movie as himself. Reagan starred in the movie.

Irving Berlin and Ronald Reagan were linked together in the Cold War defeat of the Soviet Union through the event of the November 9-11, 1989, fall of the Berlin Wall. The September 22, 1989, death of Irving Berlin occurred 2 months less 11 days before the November 11, 1989, events surrounding the fall of the Berlin Wall. Ronald Reagan as President of the United States gave his famous speech at the Brandenburg Gate and Berlin Wall on June 12, 1987, exhorting Mikhail Gorbachev of the Soviet Union to "Tear down this wall!"
