Key Understanding #1: The November 11, 1938, 20th anniversary of the November 11, 1918, armistice that ended World War I was used as the occasion for the introduction of the song "God Bless America" on network radio by singer Kate Smith.

Key Understanding #2: November 11, 1938, was 51 years [less 2 months, then add 11 days] before the September 22, 1989, death of Irving Berlin, and [exactly] 51 years before the November 9-11, 1989, dates of the fall of the Berlin Wall.
