Key Understanding #1: The matter of verifying and clarifying that the hurricanes of 1938 and 1989 represent the theme of *Gone With the Wind* is easily substantiated by the hurricane of 1989, referring to Hurricane Hugo, which struck Charleston, South Carolina, on September 21, 1989.


The printed narration that opens the film *Gone With the Wind* reads:

"There was a land of Cavaliers and Cotton Fields called the Old South. Here in this pretty world, Gallantry took its last bow. Here was the last ever to be seen of Knights and their Ladies Fair, of Master and of Slave. Look for it only in books, for it is no more than a dream remembered, <u>a</u> Civilization gone with the wind."

Charleston, South Carolina, was the site of the April 12, 1861, beginning of the U.S. Civil War, which resulted in the civilization of the Old South in the United States becoming *gone with the wind*. In short, *the wind* (of the victorious Union) *carried away* the South.

Key Understanding #2: The Lord ordained Hurricane Hugo to strike land at Charleston, South Carolina, on September 21, 1989, to verify the hurricane's role in the prophetic theme of the Civil War's *Gone With*
