The spoken introduction to Irving Berlin's "God Bless America" in 1938:

"While the storm clouds gather far across the sea [in the Czech-German crisis], Let us swear allegiance to a land [America] that's free, . . ."

Key Understanding: *The gathering storms of the two great hurricanes of September 21, 1938.* The "storm clouds gather[ing] far across the sea" in the November 10, 1938, introduction to "God Bless America" were – through the 2-month less 11-day date change – (i) *knowingly* and *literally* (but also *unknowingly prophetically*) referring to the Czech-German crisis, which had caught the world's attention in September and October of 1938 and which included the September 21, 1938, submission of the Czechs to the German will concerning the Sudetenland, and were (ii) *unknowingly* and *prophetically* referencing the Great New England Hurricane of September 21, 1938 (the genesis of which literally happened to be far across the sea in the Sahara Desert of Africa).

He will cause astounding devastation and will succeed in whatever he does. <u>HE WILL DESTROY THE MIGHTY</u> <u>MEN AND THE HOLY PEOPLE</u> [referencing the physical destruction of the Jews in the Nazi Holocaust, of which Kristallnacht of November 10, 1938, is often marked as a beginning].
