
#1838 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 97, *The Great Colonial Hurricane of 1635:* The Fall of Men/People due to the Winds of the Lord, (i) Isaiah 40:6-8 is prophetically tied to the Great Colonial Hurricane of 1635, while (ii) Matthew 7:26-27 is prophetically tied to the Great New England Hurricane of 1938

Key Understanding: *The fall of men due to the sovereign winds of the Lord*. Two key passages of scripture – (i) Isaiah 40:6-8 and (ii) Matthew 7:26-27 – explain that men/people fall due to the winds of the Lord. Isaiah 40:6-8, which warns of *men/people falling as* <u>flowers</u> in the Lord's wind, is prophetically tied to the Great Colonial Hurricane of 1635. Matthew 7:24-27, which explains that in the Lord's wind, men/people fall as a house built <u>upon the sand</u>, is prophetically tied to the Great New England Hurricane of 1938.

(i) *The flowers <u>fall</u>*. Isaiah 40:6-8 warns that *men/people <u>fall as flowers</u>* in the wind of the Lord. The passage is prophetically tied to the **Great Colonial Hurricane of 1635**.

Isaiah 40:6-7 (NIV) . . . <u>ALL MEN</u> [the number of man is 6 or VI] <u>ARE LIKE GRASS, AND ALL THEIR</u> <u>GLORY is like the [May] FLOWERS of the FIELD.</u> 7 <u>THE GRASS WITHERS and **THE FLOWERS** FALL, BECAUSE THE BREATH OF THE LORD BLOWS ON THEM [represented by the Great Colonial Hurricane of 1635]. <u>Surely THE</u> [Mather] <u>PEOPLE ARE GRASS</u>.</u>



(ii) Great was the <u>fall</u> of it. Matthew 7:26-27, which explains that men/people <u>fall</u> as a house built upon the sand in the Lord's wind, is prophetically tied to the Great New England Hurricane of 1938.

Matthew 7:26-27 (KJV) And every one thatheareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not,shall be likened unto a foolish man, WHICHBUILT HIS HOUSE UPON THEBUILT HIS HOUSE UPON THE[Dunkirk, orChurch on the Sand] SAND:27 AND THE RAIN DESCENDED, AND THEFLOODS CAME, AND THE WINDS BLEW, ANDBEAT UPON THAT HOUSE; AND IT FELL: andGREAT WAS THE FALL OF IT.
