

Daniel 8:27 (KJV) <u>And I DANIEL FAINTED, AND WAS SICK CERTAIN DAYS;</u> afterward I rose up, and did the king's business; and I was astonished at the vision, but none understood it.

Key Understanding: Daniel ill and church-ill. The Lord ordained the prophet Daniel to become physically ill (Daniel 8:27) at the end of his vision of the Ram and the Goat (Daniel 8) because the core of the prophetic interpretation of the vision would surround the theme of the future mighty men and holy people of God (Daniel 8:24) being spiritually ill – the Church-ill – particularly represented by the figure of Winston Churchill.







Daniel 8:23-24 (NIV) "In <u>THE LATTER PART OF THEIR REIGN</u>, when rebels have become completely wicked, <u>A [primary] STERN-FACED KING</u> [represented by Irving Berlin and the United States <u>and Winston Churchill of Great Britain</u>], a master of intrigue, will arise.

24 He will become very strong, but not by his own power. He will cause astounding devastation and will succeed in whatever he does. <u>HE WILL DESTROY THE MIGHTY</u> <u>MEN AND THE HOLY PEOPLE</u> [referencing the *spiritual* destruction of Christians because of their worship of and {holocaust} sacrifices to the Beast out of the Pit as "One Nation Under God," represented on November 10, 1938, by Irving Berlin's "God Bless America"].

27 <u>I, DANIEL, WAS EXHAUSTED AND LAY ILL FOR SEVERAL DAYS</u>. Then I got up and went about the king's business. I was appalled by the vision; it was beyond understanding.
