Alan Shepard and Freedom 7 on May 5, 1961. Freedom 7 was the name of Alan Shepard's Mercury capsule. The [originally] scheduled launch date for Alan Shepard and Freedom 7 was May 2, 1961. [Soviet cosmonaut Yuri Gagarin had become the first man to enter space only three weeks earlier on April 12, 1961.] Until just three hours before Shepard's flight, NASA still had not let the press know that Shepard would be the first to go. Alan was ready, the rocket was ready, and the range was ready. But Shepard did not lift off that day. Low cloud cover rolled in. The flight operations director wanted a clear view of the Redstone rocket, the Freedom 7 capsule, and its human cargo all the way through burnout. The launch was scrubbed. A new launch date was set for May 5.



May 5, 1961: Alan Shepard approaches Freedom 7

At 9:34 a.m. EST on **May 5, 1961**, in full view of a television audience of 45 million people, Alan Shepard was dramatically

lifted into space and became America's first astronaut. America's first man in space was in flight only 15 minutes and 22 seconds and was weightless only a third of that time due to the suborbital



ballistic nature of the flight. Shepard gained an altitude of 116.5 miles and [achieved] a maximum speed of 5,180 miles per hour. He landed 9.2 miles from the prime recovery ship, the aircraft carrier *Lake Champlain*. He had flown 304 miles (489 kilometers) from his Cape Canaveral launch site.

Twenty days later, on May 25, 1961, in a special message to Congress, [President] Kennedy challenged the Soviets in the space arena and put the United States

on a course to the moon by declaring that the nation should land a man on the moon and return him safely to the earth before the end of the decade. That indeed happened on July 20, 1969.

Key Understanding: The Lord ordained Alan Shepard's flight aboard Freedom 7 to be delayed from May 2 to May 5 (= 5/5 = 5:5), 1961, because the event was representing the counterfeit fulfillment of the seven shepherds of Micah 5:5. Moreover, Shepard's capsule was named Freedom 7 to also point to the seven shepherds.
