- Freedom from Want appeared in the edition of March 6, 1943.
- Freedom from Fear appeared in the edition of March 13, 1943.

The Saturday Evening Post, March 13, 1943

In addition to publishing the paintings, Curtis Publishing commissioned essays to accompany the paintings in print. Each accompanying article expounded upon the thoughts provoked by Rockwell's imagery. The editors of the Saturday Evening Post found the right author for each essay. All four authors added to the message the paintings conveyed.

- Freedom of Speech was written by Booth Tarkington (1869-1946).
- Freedom to Worship was written by essayist Will Durant (1885-1981).
- Freedom from Want was written by Philippine
- immigrant Carlos Bulosan (1914-1956).



Freedom from Fear was written by Stephen Vincent Benet (1898-1943).



Stephen Vincent Benet (*pictured left*) was a novelist and poet. Benet's well known works include *John Brown's Body* and *American Names*. Benet also wrote the short story *The Devil and Daniel Webster*. As was mentioned in Unsealing #1619 . . .


