

#1917 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 176, The Teapot Dome Scandal and the fall of Albert Fall: The Pearl Harbor Revenge of 12/8 in contrast to Romans 12:19

The revenge for Pearl Harbor. The United States of America declared war on Japan on December 8, 1941, the day after Japan's December 7, 1941, attack on Pearl Harbor. In other words, the revenge for Pearl Harbor began on December 8, 1941, and ended with the ultimate revenge through the August 6, 1945, and August 9, 1945, atomic bombs.

Key Understanding: *The 12/8 revenge for Pearl Harbor pointed to Romans 12:19. The Lord ordained the revenge for Pearl Harbor to begin on December 8 = 12/8 = 12:8 = 12:19 [with the 11-day date change] to point to the very issue of Christians not seeking revenge that is seen in Romans 12:19. The point is that the fallen earthly governments of this world are ordained by the Lord to seek revenge (Romans 13), but Christians of the Lord's heavenly kingdom are not ordained to seek revenge.*



Romans 12:17-21 (KJV) Recompense to no man evil for evil. Provide things honest in the sight of all men.

18 If it be possible, as much as lieth in you, live peaceably with all men.

19 Dearly beloved, AVENGE NOT

YOURSELVES, BUT RATHER GIVE PLACE UNTO WRATH: for it is written, VENGEANCE IS MINE; I WILL REPAY, SAITH THE LORD.

20 Therefore if thine enemy hunger, feed him; if he thirst, give him drink: for in so doing thou shalt heap coals of fire on his head.

21 Be not overcome of evil, but overcome evil with good.
