Howell Forgy was born on January 18, 1908. He played football at Muskingum College in Ohio, and was later ordained as a Presbyterian minister. Commissioned in the Navy's Chaplain Corps as a Lieutenant (Junior Grade) in October 1940, he was serving on the heavy cruiser *New Orleans* during the December 7, 1941, Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor. When men of the ship's ammunition party were growing tired

from their efforts, Chaplain Forgy encouraged them with the words "Praise the Lord and pass the ammunition, boys." This phrase inspired the immensely popular wartime song "Praise the Lord and

Pass the Ammunition," written by Frank Loesser and recorded by Kay Kyser. Chaplain Forgy served through the remainder of the Second World War, reaching the rank of Commander in November 1945. He retired in May 1946 and returned to the civilian ministry. The Reverend Howell Forgy died in Glendora, California, in January 1972.



politically set men free, as if it was a proper Christian doctrine. The Lord considers that doctrine to be a *counterfeit* of Jesus Christ dying to *spiritually* set men free. Thus, men shedding their blood to *politically* set men free – for example, through "just war" – is not a true sacrifice on behalf of Jesus Christ, but instead actually represents sacrifices to Satan, by those of the spiritual seed of Ishmael.

Key Understanding: Let us kill to make men free. "Praise the Lord and pass the ammunition!" is, of course, in the same errant spiritual vein as the Battle Hymn of the Republic's original lyric of "As He died to make men holy, let us die [and kill] to make men free." [Reference Unsealing #868.]
