Key Understanding: It was at Princeton that Congress received notification of the 'Oswald' Treaty of Paris. The Lord ordained Princeton University, the name of which is derived from William III of Orange, to be prominently associated with the end of the Revolutionary War through the September 3, 1783, 'Oswald' Peace of Paris for the purpose of confirming America's rise as the Beast out of the Pit in Revelation 17:08. [The next Unsealing will cover the role of Princeton University at the time of the end of the Revolutionary War.]

A brief overview of the early history of Princeton University. The history of Princeton University goes back to its establishment by "New Light" Presbyterians. Princeton was

originally intended to train Presbyterian ministers. It was originally founded at Elizabeth, New Jersey, in 1746 as the College of New Jersey. Its first president was Jonathan Dickinson; its second president was Aaron Burr, Sr.; its third president was Jonathan Edwards. In 1756, the college relocated to Princeton, New Jersey. Between the time of the move to Princeton in 1756 and the construction of Stanhope Hall in 1803, the college's sole building was Nassau Hall, named for William III of

England of the House of Orange-Nassau. The college also got one of its colors, orange, from William III. During the American Revolution, Princeton was occupied by both sides, and sustained heavy damage. The Battle of Princeton, fought in a nearby field in January of 1777, proved to be a decisive victory for General George Washington and his troops. From June 30, 1783, to November 4, 1783, the U.S. Congress (under the Articles of Confederation) met in Nassau Hall, making Princeton the country's capital for four months. [The College of New Jersey was renamed "Princeton University" in 1896.]
