


**Review** (from the previous Unsealing): *William IV of Orange*. Because James Madison's American Bill of Rights followed William III of Orange and the English Bill of Rights, the Lord ordained that Orange County, Virginia, where Madison's home of Montpelier was located, would be named after William IV of Orange, who followed William III of Orange.
