

Two presidents of Princeton University, one during the Revolutionary War (John Witherspoon, the only ordained clergyman to sign the Declaration of Independence), and one who was the President of the United States during World War I (U.S. President Woodrow Wilson, pictured on the right), serve as the focal point of the revelation of Princeton playing a major role in both the Revolutionary War first ascension of America and the World War I second ascension of America (which we are emphasizing in this



Unsealing) to become the 'House of Orange' Beast out of the England-Netherlands pit.



In fact, strangely enough, the presidency of Princeton would launch Wilson to the position of President of the United States.

Here are facts about Woodrow Wilson being the Presbyterian President. (The following two paragraphs are a repeat of Unsealing #180 Making the World Safe for Democracy – The Presbyterian President.)

Woodrow Wilson, the Presbyterian President. Thomas Woodrow Wilson was born in Staunton, Virginia, on December 28 or 29, 1856. He always gave December 28 as his birthday, but the Wilson family Bible indicates that he was born at 12:45 a.m. on December 29. His ancestry was Scottish and Scotch-Irish. Woodrow Wilson's mother, Janet Woodrow, was the daughter of a Presbyterian minister. Wilson's father, Joseph R. Wilson, was also a Presbyterian minister. Although originally from the Midwest, he was a founder and leader of the southern




branch of the Presbyterian Church in the United States. In 1857 the Wilsons moved to Augusta, Georgia. In 1870 they moved to Columbia, South Carolina, where Wilson's father became a professor in a Presbyterian theological seminary.

Woodrow Wilson became president of Princeton University in 1902

Woodrow Wilson attended Princeton, then known as the College of New Jersey, the fourth oldest institution of higher learning in the U.S. Only Harvard, William and Mary, and Yale are older. Princeton was originally sponsored by the Presbyterian Church. The first classes were held in the home of Jonathan Dickinson, a Presbyterian minister who served as the college's first president.

Wilson later became President of Princeton University, a position that launched him toward the governorship of New Jersey in 1910, followed by his election as the president of the United States in 1912.

Princeton University Class Day circa 1904, when Woodrow Wilson was president of the University


In the meantime, as was covered earlier in Unsealing #164 The World War I Second Ascension of America – The Double Rome Marriages: The Marriage of Ivan the Terrible to a Rome woman, and the Marriage of Woodrow Wilson to a Rome woman, Woodrow Wilson married Ellen Louise Axson, whose father had been a Presbyterian minister in Rome, Georgia.

The Lord chose a man well known for his Christian faith, Presbyterian Protestant Woodrow Wilson, to be President of the United States during World War I, to represent the 8th Kingdom, the United States of America, as it fully received its mantle as the *Fourth* Rome. This was because the United States was receiving a *religious-political* mantle from the Third Rome, and was also receiving the *religious-political* mantle as the *Fourth Christian* Roman Empire *of its day*, but for the purpose of Making the World Safe for Democracy, vs. the Autocracies of the day.
