Key Understanding: *The Nuremberg Laws*. The 1935 Nuremberg Laws defined who was a Jew, based on heredity. They formed the basis for the plans that were made on January 20, 1942, for the "Final Solution of the Jewish Question." The laws were used to determine who would be transported to concentration camps from Germany and the Nazi-occupied countries.
