Review (from Unsealing #2049): Ten (10) of the twelve (12) Nazi leaders sentenced on October 1, 1946, to die by hanging would do so. Hermann Goering – founder of the Gestapo, head of the Luftwaffe, and minister of economic affairs – committed suicide the night before his scheduled early morning execution. Martin Bormann's whereabouts were unknown, although it is now believed that he died in May 1945.



Key Understanding: The ten hangings to match up with the hangings of Haman's ten sons. The Lord ordained Hermann Goering's suicide in the hours before his scheduled early morning execution so that there would be ten hangings at Nuremberg on October 16, 1946, to match up with the hangings of Haman's ten sons. Since they had already been slain (Esther 9:10), the 'hangings' of the ten sons of Haman (Esther 9:13-14) were actually a display – a gibbeting – of the corpses, on gallows.

Esther 9:5-14 (NIV) The Jews struck down all their enemies with the sword, killing and destroying them, and they did what they pleased to those who hated them.

13 "If it pleases the king," Esther answered, "give the Jews in Susa permission to carry out this day's edict tomorrow also, and <u>LET HAMAN'S TEN SONS BE HANGED ON</u> <u>GALLOWS</u>."

14 So the king commanded that this be done. An edict was issued in Susa, and <u>THEY HANGED THE TEN SONS OF HAMAN</u>.
