Here is **#2056–Doc 1**, which shows the complete **Hebrew calendar for the year 5707**. Note that the year 5707 in the Hebrew year started on the eve of September 26, 1946, and ended on September 14, 1947. The first day of the Hebrew year was the first day of Tishri (Tishrei), September 26, 1946, while the tenth day of Tishri – Yom Kippur – was October 5, 1946.

Here is **#2056–Doc 2**, which correlates the dates in **the modern Western calendar for October 1946** (that is, October 1-31, 1946) with the days in the Hebrew calendar for the year 5707. Obviously, what this calendar illustrates will be exactly the same as what the calendar shown in Doc 1 (*above*) illustrates, except it shows the month of October only. Note that Yom Kippur was on October 5, 1946, and is especially highlighted.

Key Understanding: *October 5, 1946, Yom Kippur.* Yom Kippur in the Jewish year of 5707 was October 5, 1946, 11 days before the October 16, 1946, judgment at Nuremberg through the hanging of ten leading Nazi figures.

**ATONEMENT**, to make an atonement for you before the LORD your God. 29 For whatsoever soul it be that shall not be afflicted in that same day, he shall be cut off from among his people. 30 And whatsoever soul it be that doeth any work in that same day, the same soul will I destroy from among his people.

31 Ye shall do no manner of work: it shall be a statute for ever throughout your generations in all your dwellings.
