

**Review** (from Unsealing #2058, #2060, and #2061): *The fall feasts*. There are three feasts in the fall, in the seventh (7<sup>th</sup>) month of Tishri (Tishrei): (i) the Feast of Trumpets (Rosh Hashanah), which begins on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of Tishri; (ii) the Feast of the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Tishri; and (iii) the Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkoth), which begins on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of Tishri.

Key Understanding: *The Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkoth)*. The Feast of Tabernacles is also seen in Exodus, Deuteronomy, and Numbers.

## The Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot) in Exodus

Exodos 23:14-16 (KJV) Three times thou shalt keep a feast unto me in the year. 15 Thou shalt keep the feast of unleavened bread: (thou shalt eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded thee, in the time appointed of the month Abib; for in it thou camest out from Egypt: and none shall appear before me empty:)

16 And the feast of harvest, the firstfruits of thy labours, which thou hast sown in the field: and THE FEAST OF INGATHERING, which is in the end of the year, when thou hast gathered in thy labours out of the field.

## The Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkot) in Deuteronomy

## Deuteronomy 16:13-16 (KJV) <u>THOU SHALT OBSERVE THE FEAST OF</u> <u>TABERNACLES SEVEN DAYS, after that thou hast gathered in thy corn and thy wine:</u>


14 And thou shalt rejoice in thy feast, thou, and thy son, and thy daughter, and thy manservant, and thy maidservant, and the Levite, the stranger, and the fatherless, and the widow, that are within thy gates.

15 Seven days shalt thou keep a solemn feast unto the LORD thy God in the place which the LORD shall choose: because the LORD thy God shall bless thee in all thine increase, and in all the works of thine hands, therefore thou shalt surely rejoice.

16 Three times in a year shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God in the place which he shall choose; in the feast of unleavened bread, and in the feast of weeks, <u>and IN THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES</u>: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:
