
#2070 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a second Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 329, Nuremberg Day of Judgment, (xxxii), Hoshana Rabbah, the seventh day of the Feast of Booths (Sukkot)

Review (from Unsealings #2058, #2060, #2061, and #2062): *The fall feasts*. There are three feasts in the fall, in the seventh (7th) month of Tishri (Tishrei): (i) the Feast of Trumpets (Rosh Hashanah), which begins on the 1st day of Tishri; (ii) the Feast of the Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur), the 10th day of Tishri; and (iii) the Feast of Tabernacles (Sukkoth), which begins on the 15th day of Tishri.

Hoshana Rabbah. The seventh day of Sukkot (the Feast of Tabernacles, or the Feast of Booths) is called *Hoshana Rabbah*.

Review (from Unsealing #2056): *October 5, 1946, Yom Kippur*. Yom Kippur in the Jewish year of 5707 was October 5, 1946, 11 days before the October 16, 1946, judgment at Nuremberg through the hanging of ten high profile Nazis.

Key Understanding: *October 16, 1946, Hoshana Rabbah*. Before we go any further, let's understand that the October 16, 1946, Nuremberg day of judgment for ten leading Nazis occurred on *Hoshana Rabbah*, the seventh day of Sukkot(h), which was also 11 days after Yom Kippur on October 5, 1946.

Here is #2070–Doc 1, which is the same as #2056–Doc 2, and which correlates the dates in the modern Western calendar for October 1946 (that is, October 1-31, 1946), with the days in the Hebrew calendar for the year 5707. Note that Yom Kippur was on October 5, 1946, and is especially highlighted, and that Hoshana Rabbah was on October 16, 1946.

The Feast of Booths (Sukkot), beginning the 15th day of the month of Tishri, and ending on the 21st (the 7th day), Hoshana Rabbah

Leviticus 23:33-34, 41-43 (KJV) And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,

- 34 Speak unto the children of Israel, saying, <u>THE FIFTEENTH DAY OF THIS SEVENTH MONTH SHALL BE THE FEAST OF TABERNACLES FOR SEVEN DAYS UNTO THE LORD</u>.
- 41 <u>And ye shall keep it a feast unto the Lord seven days in the year</u>. It shall be a statute for ever in your generations: <u>Ye shall celebrate it in the seventh month</u>.
- 42 <u>YE SHALL DWELL IN BOOTHS</u> [huts] <u>seven days; ALL THAT ARE ISRAELITES</u> <u>BORN SHALL DWELL IN BOOTHS</u> [huts]:
- 43 <u>That your generations may know that I made the children of Israel TO DWELL IN</u>
 <u>BOOTHS</u> [huts], <u>WHEN I BROUGHT THEM OUT OF THE LAND OF EGYPT</u>: I am the LORD your God.
