
Key Understanding: *Julius Streicher*. Julius Streicher has been described as "the man who persuaded a nation [Germany] to hate Jews."

Here are the first two paragraphs of a long article on Julius Streicher from the Jewish Virtual Library:

Through his words and his deeds Julius Streicher assumed for himself the unofficial title of "Jew-baiter Number One" of Nazi Germany. For the course of some twenty-five years, Streicher educated the German people in hatred and incited them to the persecution and to the extermination of the Jewish race. He was an accessory to murder, on a scale perhaps never attained before.

Streicher was born in 1885. He became a school teacher in Nürnberg and formed a party of his own, which he called the German Socialist Party. The chief policy of that party was anti-semitism. In 1922 he handed over his party to Hitler, who wrote a glowing account of Streicher's generosity in Mein Kampf.
