Luke 22:63-65 (KJV) <u>AND THE MEN THAT HELD JESUS MOCKED HIM, AND SMOTE HIM.</u>

64 And when they had blindfolded him, THEY STRUCK HIM ON THE FACE, and asked him, saying, Prophesy, who is it that smote thee?

65 And many other things blasphemously spake they against him.

Galatians 6:7 (KJV) Be not deceived; GOD IS NOT MOCKED: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Review (from the previous Unsealing): Jesus Christ was mocked at the same time that he was being struck (Luke 22:63-65). But God will not be mocked, and the fulfillment of that is His mocking of the mocking and striking of his Son through Julius Streicher.

But now *spitting* is added to the *mocking* and the *striking*:

Key Understanding: <u>Hel Spit</u> and the <u>spitters</u> and the <u>mockers</u> and the <u>strikers</u>. At the time when Jesus Christ was <u>mocked</u> and <u>struck</u>, he was also <u>spat</u> upon. It is for this reason that the Lord ordained what is known as Hel Spit to begin the story of the German invasion and occupation of Poland, the nation in which Auschwitz and other concentration camps/death camps were then constructed which would be used to exterminate millions of Jews.

[Note: Luke 22:63-65 (above), Mark 14:63-65 (below), and Matthew 26:65-68 (below) are synoptic, recounting the same events.]

Mark 14:63-65 (KJV) Then the high priest [Caiaphas] rent his clothes, and saith, What need we any further witnesses?

64 Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

65 AND SOME BEGAN TO SPIT ON HIM, and to

cover his face, and to buffet him, and to say unto him, Prophesy: and <u>THE SERVANTS DID</u> <u>STRIKE HIM WITH THE PALMS OF THEIR HANDS</u>.

Matthew 26:65-68 (KJV) Then the high priest rent his clothes, saying, He hath spoken blasphemy; what further need have we of witnesses? behold, now ye have heard his blasphemy.

66 What think ye? They answered and said, He is guilty of death.

67 <u>THEN DID THEY SPIT IN HIS FACE</u>, and buffeted him; and <u>OTHERS SMOTE HIM</u> <u>WITH THE PALMS OF THEIR HANDS</u>,

68 Saying, Prophesy unto us, thou Christ, WHO IS HE THAT SMOTE THEE?
