Key Understanding: *The dispute over the Polish Corridor, which included Hel Spit.* The Polish Corridor refers to a corridor of land that allowed Poland to be linked to the Baltic Sea, which encompassed land that belonged to Germany in World War I, and, furthermore, which now split in two what was part of Germany during World War I. Adolf Hitler's premise for beginning World War II significantly surrounded the dispute over the city of Danzig (Gdansk, Poland today) and the Polish Corridor, which included Hel Spit. The spiritual/prophetic and even historical point is that the Lord ordained the land (the Polish Corridor) that included the Hel Spit to be directly linked to Hitler's excuse for the invasion and occupation of Poland – which led to the death of millions of Jews – for the purpose of illustrating that the Lord was not going to be mocked concerning the mocking of, spitting upon, striking of, and crucifixion of his Son, Jesus Christ.

To begin to understand the background behind the dispute over the Polish Corridor – of which the Hel Spit was a part, and which became a major reason for Germany's invasion of Poland – let's look at a map of Poland in 1939 that actually identifies what is called the Polish Corridor.

Here is **#2094–Doc 1**, a map of **Poland in 1939**. Note that while the map has faithfully identified the Polish Corridor and the city of Hel, it unfaithfully enlarges the size of Hel Spit. Also, please note the green-shaded land of what is shown as Danzig, but was known as the "Free City of Danzig."
