Key Understanding: The Lord's double pale horse judgments of (i) death, with (ii) hell following. The Nazi Holocaust of Jews in the Pale represented a part of the fulfillment of the Lord's judgment through the rider on the Pale Horse, whose name is Death, with Hell following. "Death, with Hell following" means just what it says, and constitutes a double judgment by the Lord through the Pale Horse Rider.

The Lord's purpose in the Battle of Hel on Hel Spit was the foreboding message that Death was coming, with Hell following.

Revelation 6:7-8 (KJV) And when he had opened THE FOURTH SEAL, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see.

8 And I looked, and behold A PALE HORSE: and his name that sat on him was DEATH, AND HELL followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth.
