

## part 382, The History of the Pale of Settlement, (ix), The Jews in Lithuania suddenly became Russian Jews

Key Understanding: *The Jews in Lithuania became Russian Jews*. As a result of the partitions of Poland, the Russian Empire was suddenly sovereign over the great number of Jews who had immigrated over several centuries into the previous safe haven of Lithuania.

*Below* is another map illustrating that Jews fled eastward from Germany, Austria, and Hungary to Polandenlarged Lithuania. Jewish life flourished in Poland. Polish rulers welcomed Jews during the 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> centuries, issuing charters of legal rights for Jews. However, enlarged Lithuania became a part of Russia through the three partitions of Poland in 1772, 1793, and 1795, and Russia would turn it into the Pale of Settlement for Russian Jews.
