

Review (from Unsealing #2126): *The larger Pale of Settlement*. The Polish Partitions ended in 1795. However, maps of the Pale of Settlement often include the central part of Poland, most of which was occupied by Prussia (Germany) and Austria, not Russia, directly after the Polish Partitions. An event occurred after 1795 that caused the central part of Poland to be included in the larger definition of the Pale of Settlement.

Key Understanding: *The larger Pale of Settlement*. The larger definition of the Pale of Settlement – which is the size of the Pale of Settlement most often depicted – included <u>the</u> central part of Poland and the city of Warsaw.
