

The New Colossus

“Keep, ancient lands, your storied pomp!” cries she
 With silent lips. “**Give me your tired, your poor,**
 Your huddled masses yearning to breathe free,
 The wretched refuse of your teeming shore,
 Send these, the homeless, tempest-tost to me,
 I lift my lamp beside the golden door!”

Key Understanding: Give me your tired, your poor. Emma Lazarus’s words “Give me your tired, your poor” in *The New Colossus* are a counterfeited of Lazarus in Luke 16:19-23 representing *poor vs. the rich man*, further emphasizing that Emma Lazarus and the Statue of Liberty, in conjunction with the Pale of Settlement – prophetically representing the Pale Horse and its rider, Death, with Hell following – were ordained by the Lord to be thematically tied to Luke 16:19-23.

Poor Lazarus vs. the rich man

*Luke 16:19-23 (KJV) There was a certain **RICH MAN**, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:*

20 And there was a certain [poor] **BEGGAR NAME LAZARUS**, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,

21 And desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from **THE RICH MAN'S TABLE**: moreover the dogs came and licked his sores.

22 And it came to pass, that **THE BEGGAR** [Lazarus] **DIED**, and was carried by the angels into **ABRAHAM'S BOSOM**: **THE RICH MAN ALSO DIED**, and was buried;

23 And **IN HELL** he lift up his eyes, being in torments, and seeth Abraham afar off, and **LAZARUS IN HIS** [Abraham's] **BOSOM**.
