#2167 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes,

part 426, The Pale Horse, (xxiii), The Pale of Settlement and the U.S. entry into World War I, and Hitler's invasion of Poland to begin World War II

Review: The question at hand is how and why (Step 1) Alexander Kerensky's democratic Provisional Government ending the Pale of Settlement on April 2, 1917, is *historically* and *prophetically* related to (Step 2) the rise of Adolf Hitler's Third Reich as a Pale Horse Rider through the Nazi extermination of Jews in what had been the Pale of Settlement.

Key Understanding: The Pale of Settlement and the U.S. <u>entry into</u> World War I, and Hitler's invasion of Poland to <u>begin</u> World War II. The ending of the Pale of Settlement occurred on April 2, 1917, the day Woodrow Wilson asked America to <u>enter into</u> World War I, while Hitler invaded Poland – which formerly (as Poland-Lithuania) possessed the region that became known as the Pale of Settlement – to <u>begin</u> World War II and fulfill a part of the prophetic role of the Pale Horse Rider.

Step 1

World War I: Alexander Kerensky's democratic Provisional Government ended the Pale of Settlement on April 2, 1917, the date Woodrow Wilson asked America to enter into World War I

April 2, 1917 – Woodrow Wilson's war message

President Woodrow Wilson entered the packed and cheering chamber of the House of Representatives at 8:32 p.m., April 2, 1917. The speech included . . .

<u>The world must be made safe for democracy</u>. Its peace must be planted upon the tested foundations of political liberty.
