

Question: Power is given to the Pale Horse and its rider over the fourth part of the earth. But what is "the fourth part of the earth?"

Key Understanding and Answer: *The fourth part of the earth.* Power is given to the Pale Horse and its rider over "the fourth part of the earth." The "fourth part of the earth" has layered understandings in its fulfillment, but the primary understanding of the meaning behind the "fourth part of the earth" is that the New World in the Western Hemisphere – even after the time that it was called "America" (beginning in 1507) – was specifically referred to as the "fourth part of the world." The first three parts of the world were considered to be Europe, Asia, and Africa.
