

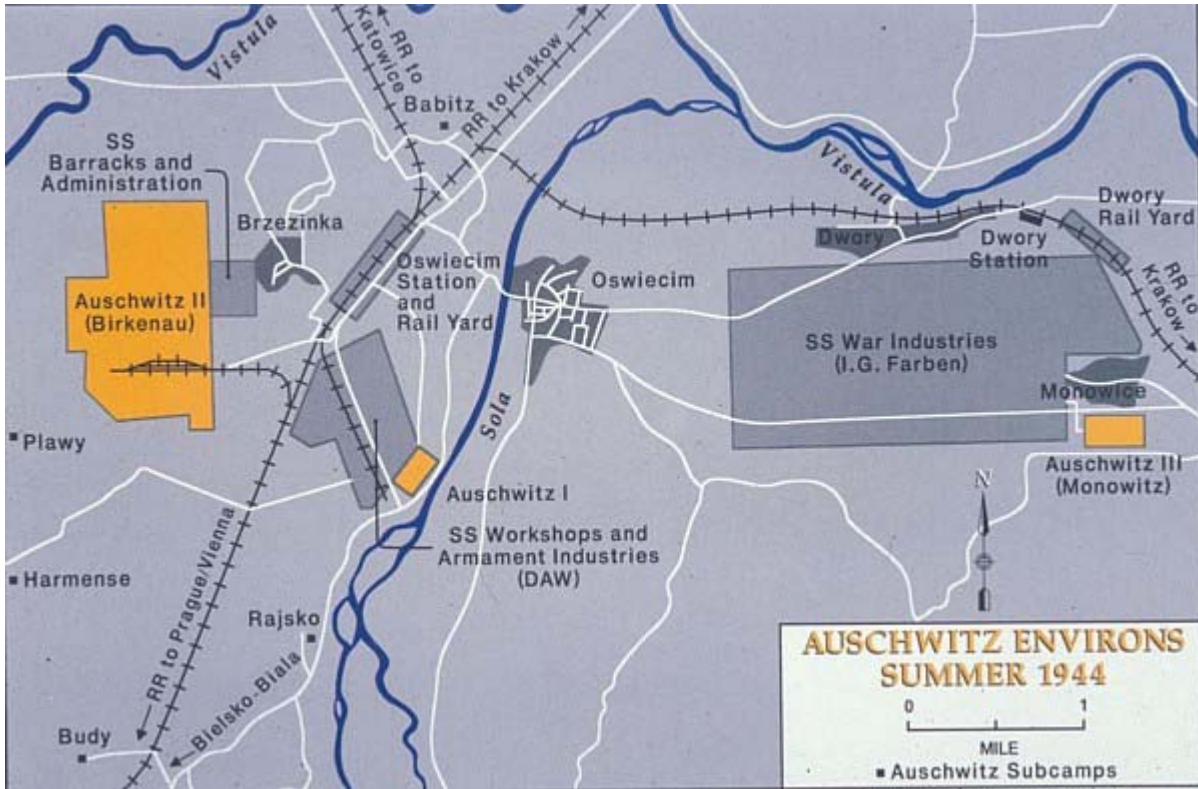
#2192 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 451, The Pale Horse, (xlviii), The Fourth Part of the Earth: Austria’s connections to Hitler’s role as a Pale Horse Rider

Key Understanding #1: Austria’s link to the Nazi death camps. Austria’s connections to Hitler’s role as a Pale Horse Rider during World War II that were connected to the earlier (1772, 1793, 1795, and 1815) Polish partitions included the fact that the most notorious death camp of World War II – Auschwitz (now Oswiecim), 30 miles from Krakow – was located on the southern side of the Vistula River in what was Austria’s portion of the 1772 Polish partition. (See the map on page 2.) What was called Auschwitz I, and which served as the administrative center for the whole complex, was founded on May 20, 1940, on the basis of an old Polish brick army barracks which were originally built by the Austrian-Hungarian Empire.

Key Understanding #2: Germany-Austria. After World War I, many Austrians wanted to make Austria a part of Germany, but it was forbidden by the Allies through the 1919 Treaty of St. Germain. In 1938, German troops seized Austria, with Hitler announcing the union of Germany and Austria. Austria’s fate became tied to Nazi Germany’s as it rode the Pale Horse.



Below is a map of Auschwitz environments in the summer of 1944. The Duchy of Oswiecim, or the Duchy of Auschwitz, was annexed by the Habsburg Empire in the First Partition of Poland in 1772.
