part 457, The Pale Horse, (liv), The Pale Horse Rider Assassins: The Pale Assassins

Key Understanding: *The Pale Assassin*. Trifko Grabez played the prophetic role of the Pale Assassin.



Grabez and Pale. Of the group of assassins intent on killing Archduke Franz Ferdinand, it was Gavrilo Princip who accomplished the task. Princip's close associate leading up to the assassination was Trifko Grabez. It was Trifko Grabez who was connected to Pale, and thus he is prophetically designed by the Lord to be called "the Pale Assassin." The connection is that Grabez was born to a Serbian-Orthodox priest in the city of Pale. Grabez stayed at his parents' home in Pale shortly before the assassination. Taking it a step further, because of Grabez's immense role in the assassination plot, the entire group may be referred to as "the Pale Assassins."

Trifko Grabez's involvement (especially with Gavrilo Princip) as the Pale Assassin included the following:

The Pale Assassin – Trifko Grabez was born to a Serbian-Orthodox priest in Pale.

The Pale Assassin – Princip, Grabez, and Cabrinovic were considered the initial three principal assassins.

The Pale Assassin – Princip roomed with **Grabez** in Belgrade, Serbia, in early 1914, shortly before the assassination.

The Pale Assassin – It was **Grabez** who initially represented the group when securing the assassination weapons from a Major Tankosic, in Belgrade.

The Pale Assassin – Princip and **Grabez** transported the weapons across the frontier from Belgrade, Serbia, into Bosnia. The journey began on May 28, 1914.

The Pale Assassin – After their one week journey, the conspirators split in Sarajevo. **Grabez** went to stay with his parents at Pale.

The Pale Assassin – **Grabez** stationed himself along the Archduke's route, but failed to shoot when the Archduke passed by the first time. He, like Princip, resolved himself to kill the Archduke if he came back by, but failed to do something the second time as well. Princip, however, successfully completed the assassination.
