The Pale slaying of the tsarist Russian Empire in World War I by Alexander Kerensky's democratic Provisional Government (Kerensky is pictured in front of the Pale) is represented and symbolized by the Kerensky government officially "ending" the Pale of Settlement on April 2, 1917, the day of U.S. President Woodrow Wilson's war message to Congress.





The Pale slaying of Austria

The Pale slaying of the Austrian-Hungarian Empire in World War I is symbolized by the Pale assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand. [Trifko Grabez was from Pale, Bosnia.]
