

Matthew 26:52 (KJV) Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: FOR ALL THEY THAT TAKE THE SWORD SHALL PERISH WITH THE SWORD.

The subject matter of the previous Unsealing was about those associated with the Pale Horse Rider bringing Death to *others*, with Hell following for *themselves*. Closely related – and at the heart of the matter of Death, with Hell following – is the aspect of those associated with the Pale Horse Rider bringing Death to *themselves*, with Hell following for *themselves*.

Key Understanding #1: Dying to make men free. The theme of those associated with the Pale Horse Rider bringing Death to themselves, with Hell following for themselves, is summed up in the doctrine in the original lyrics to the U.S. Civil War's Battle Hymn of the Republic, "let us die to make men free." The reason why the words of 'let us die to make men free' are at the heart of the matter of those of the Pale Horse Rider bringing both Death and Hell to themselves is because the doctrine is a counterfeit of Jesus Christ dying on the cross to set men free.

Key Understanding #2: The warning of "for all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword" corresponds to "death, and hell following," in Revelation 6:8. 'Let us die to make men free,' which is similar to Peter wielding the sword to set Jesus free, corresponds to the warning from Jesus Christ that "all they that take the sword shall perish with the sword" (Matthew 26:52) and points to Death (either to others or to themselves), with Hell following (Revelation 6:8), meaning a spiritual perishing.

Matthew 26:52 (KJV) Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: FOR ALL THEY THAT TAKE THE SWORD SHALL PERISH WITH THE SWORD.

Revelation 6:8 (KJV) And I looked, and behold A PALE HORSE: and his name that sat on him was DEATH, AND HELL FOLLOWED WITH HIM. And power was given unto them over THE FOURTH PART OF THE EARTH, TO KILL (i) WITH SWORD, and (ii) with hunger, and (iii) with death, and (iv) with the beasts of the earth.
