The unique historical and prophetic relationship between Constantine and Woodrow Wilson has been covered extensively in <u>Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson</u> (Unsealings #661–#662), <u>Constantine the Great and Woodrow Wilson, II</u> (Unsealings #743–#786), and Unsealing #1050.

The critical understandings were as follows: the spirit of Constantine was Making the World Safe for *Christianity*, while the spirit of Woodrow Wilson was Making the World Safe for *Democracy*. Remember, there is a natural timeline of history that stretches from Constantine to Woodrow Wilson, with Constantine representing the beginning of the *Second* Rome Christian *Autocracy* (and the birth of the Greek Orthodox Byzantine Empire), which carried through all the way to the end of the *Third* Rome Christian *Autocracy* of the ruling Romanov Dynasty (and the Eastern Orthodox Russian Empire), which gave way to the *Fourth* Rome Christian *Democracy* of the United States. In those roles, Constantine and Woodrow Wilson were each White Horse Riders.

Key Understanding: Constantine and Woodrow Wilson as white horse riders and pale horse riders. However, with the help of the Lord's clue by way of Constantine's father, Constantius Chlorus, the Pale, it is clear that just as Woodrow Wilson was a 'Christian' sword-carrying Pale Horse Rider, bringing Death, with Hell following, to the saints, so too
