part 567, The Prince That Shall Come, (xvi), Pale: Why the city has become known as 'Serb Sarajevo'

Why and how Pale <u>historically</u> recently became known as 'Serb Sarajevo'. During the 1992-1995 War in Bosnia, Pale was known as the de facto capital of Republic Srpska (Serb Republic), because Sarajevo was supposed to be the actual capital. Pale's population swelled during the war to 30,000 as Serbs moved from Sarajevo and other parts of Bosnia and Herzegovina to the city. Pale is referred to by many of its Serb inhabitants – and in fact by many of the inhabitants of the Serb Republic – as 'Serb Sarajevo', even though several kilometers separate the borders of the city of Sarajevo and the city of Pale. Pale continues to be referred to as 'Serb Sarajevo' due to the fact that, after the 1995 Dayton Peace Accords, Sarajevo-proper was designated as belonging to the Muslim-Croat Federation, but Bosnian Serbs, having lived in Sarajevo for generations themselves, wanted to retain some claim to their city. As a result, in an attempt to echo belonging to Sarajevo, and stake some claim to it, Pale, the closest Serb settlement to Sarajevo (within the Serb Republic), became known as 'Serb Sarajevo', albeit with a hint of sarcasm by many people, without regard to their ethnicity.

Key Understanding: Why prophetically Pale has recently become known as 'Serb Sarajevo'. As a modern-day 'Serb Sarajevo', Pale became connected to Sarajevo as a result of the 1992-1995 War in Bosnia to point back to Pale's link with Sarajevo through the 'Pale' assassination of Archduke Franz Ferdinand in Sarajevo that sparked World War I, all to confirm the rise of the Pale Horse Rider through the events of World War I. Furthermore, the 1914-1918 World War I Pale-Sarajevo connection and the 1992-1995 War in Bosnia Pale-Sarajevo connection are themselves linked together as the 1992-1995 War in Bosnia was wrapped around the continuation of the pre-World War I Serb dream for Serbs in Bosnia to be united with Serbia.
