Key Understanding: 76 years from the Balfour Declaration to the Rabin-Arafat peace accord. Again, we will be returning to understand the fuller meaning behind the September 13, 1993, peace accord during Bill Clinton's presidency, but for now, let's understand that there were 76 years (less 2 months, then add 11 days) between the November 2, 1917, Balfour Declaration during Woodrow Wilson's administration and the September 13, 1993, Clinton-Rabin-Arafat peace accord (the Oslo Accords) in Washington D.C. The Lord's purpose for the 76 years will be discussed later. [The Balfour Declaration was covered in Unsealings #1256-#1257, #1270-#1271, #1274, #1379, #1392, #2007, #2317.]
