part 648, <u>Building the Christian-Jewish-Arab Temple</u>, (xxvii), <u>Of Ishmael's Seed:</u> <u>Comparing the passage of John 8:31-39 with Galatians 4:21-31</u>

Key Understanding: The scriptural answer as to why Christians and Jews can be considered to be the spiritual children of Hagar and Ishmael is found not only in Galatians 4:21-31 but also in John 8:31-39. Let's start with John 8:31-39.

John 8:31-39 (KJV) Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

32 And ye shall know the truth, and <u>THE TRUTH SHALL</u> MAKE YOU FREE.

33 They answered him, <u>WE BE ABRAHAM'S SEED, AND</u> <u>WERE NEVER IN BONDAGE TO ANY MAN</u>: how sayest thou, <u>YE SHALL BE MADE FREE</u>?

34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, WHOSOEVER COMMITTETH SIN IS THE SERVANT OF SIN.

35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever.

36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed.

37 <u>I KNOW THAT YE ARE ABRAHAM'S SEED</u> [through Isaac]; <u>but ye seek to kill me</u>, because my word hath no place in you. [Therefore, though you are still Abraham's seed through

Isaac, it is spiritually as if you are Abraham's seed through Ishmael.]


38 I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father.

39 They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, <u>IF YE</u>

<u>WERE ABRAHAM'S CHILDREN</u> [through *Isaac*, and of the true faith of Abraham], <u>YE WOULD DO THE WORKS OF ABRAHAM</u>.

Galatians 4:21-31 (KJV) Tell me, ye that desire to be under the law, do ye not hear the law? [NIV . . . Tell me, you who want to be under the law, are you not aware of what the law says?] 22 For it is written, that Abraham had two sons, the one by a bondmaid, the other by a freewoman. [NIV . . . For it is written that Abraham had two sons, one by the slave woman and the other by the free woman.]

23 But he who was of the bondwoman was born after the flesh; but he of the freewoman was by promise. [NIV . . . His son by the slave woman was born in the ordinary way; but his son by the free woman was born as the result of a promise.]

Hagar and Ishmael




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24 Which things are an allegory: for these are the two covenants; the one from the mount Sinai, which gendereth to bondage, which is Agar. [NIV . . . These things may be taken figuratively, for the women represent two covenants. One covenant is from Mount Sinai and bears children who are to be slaves: This is Hagar.]

25 For this Agar is
mount Sinai in
Arabia, and
answereth to
JERUSALEM
WHICH NOW IS,
AND IS IN
BONDAGE WITH
HER CHILDREN.

[NIV . . . Now Hagar stands for {the law of} Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present city of Jerusalem, because she is in slavery with her children.]




26 <u>But JERUSALEM</u>
<u>WHICH IS ABOVE</u>
<u>IS FREE, WHICH IS</u>
<u>THE MOTHER OF</u>
<u>US ALL</u>. [NIV . . .

But the Jerusalem that is above is free, and she is our mother.]

[Note: This is speaking of the heavenly New Jerusalem of which true Christians who have forsaken in their hearts their earthly kingdom citizenships are citizens.]









27 For it is written, Rejoice, thou barren that bearest not; break forth and cry, thou that travailest not: for the desolate hath many more children than she which hath an husband. [NIV . . . For it is written: "Be glad, O barren woman, who bears no children; break forth and cry aloud, you who have no labor pains; because more are the children of the desolate woman than of her who has a husband."]

28 Now we, brethren, as Isaac was, are the children of promise. [NIV . . . Now you, brothers, like Isaac, are children of promise.]

29 But as then he that was born after the flesh persecuted him that was born after the Spirit, even so it is now. [NIV . . . At that time the son born in the ordinary way persecuted the son born by the power of the Spirit. It is the same now.]

30 Nevertheless what saith the scripture? Cast out the bondwoman and her son: for the son of the bondwoman shall not be heir with the son of the freewoman. [NIV . . . But what does Scripture say? "Get rid of the slave woman and her son, for the slave woman's son will never share in the inheritance with the free woman's son."]

31 So then, brethren, we are not children of the bondwoman, but of the free. [NIV . . . Therefore, brothers, we are not children of the slave woman, but of the free woman.]

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
