

Jerusalem was back in the hands of 'Christian' nations for the first time in hundreds of years. Far away from Jerusalem in London, Bonar Law, Chancellor of the Exchequer for Great Britain, made a formal announcement to the House of Commons, in which he stated, "The capture of Jerusalem has been in some degree delayed in consequence of the great care which has been taken to avoid damage to sacred places in and around the city."

> Christian churches around the world, including Westminster Cathedral in London (*right*) and the Notre Dame cathedral in Paris (*below*), celebrated the capture of Jerusalem from the Moslem Turks





The great bell of Westminster Cathedral rang for the first time in three years. The bells of every church in Rome rang for an hour. In Paris there was a special service in Notre Dame. Wireless messages

flashed around the world. Every newspaper in the English language was full of the capture of Jerusalem. It was, after years of World War I wretchedness and misery, an event which captured

and held the imagination of the world. Allenby's name was on everyone's lips, as no other general's had been during World War I.

In Palestine itself, Allenby was hailed by a considerable section of the population as a prophet, Nebi, who by tradition was to enter Jerusalem on foot and make it a city of great prosperity and power. They called from the streets: "Allah Nebi".

The holy places of the Jerusalem area were quickly occupied by British troops. Allenby went to Bethlehem. The church bells rang and all the populace turned out.
