*Galatians 6:7 (KJV)* Be not deceived; <u>GOD IS NOT MOCKED</u>: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap.

Key Understanding: *The mocking of God about the raising up of a temple in three days*. The theme of the 'dead stones' temple of God that was destroyed in 70 A.D. is interconnected with the *construction*, or *raising up*, of a *counterfeit* 'living stones' temple of God at "the time of the end," in conjunction with <u>the beginning of the Third Day</u>, as a *counterfeit* of *"destroy this temple, and in <u>three days</u> I will raise it up."* It is a mockery of the truth and a mocking of God.



The destruction of the 'dead stones' temple of God is interconnected with (through the event of the August 23-24, 1929, Hebron Massacre)...

*Matthew 24:1-2 (KJV)* And Jesus went out, and departed from <u>the</u> <u>temple</u>: and his disciples came to him for to shew him <u>the buildings of</u> <u>the temple</u>.

2 And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, <u>THERE SHALL NOT BE LEFT HERE ONE STONE</u> <u>UPON ANOTHER, THAT SHALL NOT BE THROWN DOWN</u>.

... the <u>construction</u>, or <u>raising up</u>, of a *counterfeit* 'living stones' temple of God at <u>the beginning of the Third Day</u>



John 2:18-22 (KJV) Then answered the Jews and said unto him, What sign shewest thou unto us, seeing that thou doest these things?
