



Ronald Reagan's final words in his Farewell Address to the nation (*left*) on January 11, 1989, a few days before he finished his second term as President of the United States, characterized America as a "shining city upon a hill." His words were exciting and powerful and brought chills to patriotic Christians in America, but they actually represented the seduction of false doctrine, and were a counterfeit of Matthew 5:14.



Upon a Hill. In his address, Reagan called Winthrop "an early Pilgrim, an early freedom man," words that easily bridged any gap from the Puritan objective of religious freedom in 1630's Boston as part of the City Upon a Hill to Boston's Revolutionary War identity as The Cradle of Liberty. [Note: The 1620 Pilgrims were Separatists, separating from the Church of England, and thus were different than the 1630's Puritans, who were not necessarily separating from, but rather were attempting to purify, the Church of England.]
