

#2496 The Yom Kippur War and the Abomination of Desolation – The post-World War II U.S. waxing great toward the South and toward the East as a *second* Syria/Antiochus IV Epiphanes, part 755, **Smyrna Jews, (xiv), The assassination of King George I of Greece brings King Constantine I to the throne in time for the attempt to construct a Greek state likened in size and purpose to a *second* Byzantine Empire**



King Constantine I

King George I (pictured on the right) was king of Greece from 1863 to 1913. He was only 17 years old when he was elected King by the Greek National Assembly. His 50-year reign was characterized by territorial gains as Greece established its place in pre-World War I Europe. On March 18, 1913, while out on an afternoon walk near the White Tower during a visit to Thessaloniki, two weeks short of the fiftieth anniversary of his accession, and during the First Balkan War, he was assassinated.



King George I

His son, **King Constantine I**, took the throne. (Another son, Andrew, was the father of Prince Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, husband of Queen Elizabeth II of England.)

Unsuccessful attempt at a *second* Byzantine Empire under Greek King Constantine I

Key Understanding: *The prophetic reason for the assassination of Greece's King George I. The Lord ordained the assassination of King George I of Greece for the purpose of making way for Constantine I to be on the throne at the time of the attempt by Greece to*

*construct a Greek state that could be likened to a *second* Byzantine Empire, which would have been a *double* of Constantine I (Constantine the Great) founding the *first* Byzantine Empire.*
