
part 818, The 1947-1948 Tribe of Dan, (xix), From Dan to Beersheba

Key Understanding #1: From Dan to Beersheba. In scripture, and historically, the general phrase used to describe the land of Israel from its northern end to its southern end was/is "from Dan to Beersheba."

- 1 Samuel 3:19-20 (KJV) And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him, and did let none of his words fall to the ground.
- 20 And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel was established to be a prophet of the LORD.
- 2 Samuel 3:10 (KJV) To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.
- 2 Samuel 17:11 (KJV) Therefore I counsel that all Israel be generally gathered unto thee, from Dan even to Beersheba, as the sand that is by the sea for multitude; and that thou go to battle in thine own person.
- **2 Samuel 24:1-2 (KJV)** And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.
- 2 For the king said to Joab the captain of the host, which was with him, Go now through all the tribes of Israel, from Dan even to Beersheba, and number ye the people, that I may know the number of the people.

Key Understanding #2: Thus *Dan* represented the very northern part of Israel.





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
