Israel's May 14-15, 1948, independence was declared in the city of Tel Aviv, which is located on land that was allocated to the tribe of Dan when Israel entered the Promised Land. The Lord ordained the birth of Israel to be declared in the land of Dan in the year 1948 to point to Joshua 19:48, for the purpose of illustrating the prophetic point that the Jews who founded Israel in 1948, and the Jews of Israel today, are of "the tribe of Dan," the tribe that is omitted in Revelation chapter 7.

Joshua 19:48 (KJV) This is the inheritance of the tribe of the children of Dan according to their families, these cities with their villages.
