Key Understanding #1: The Battle of Beersheba "freed" Jerusalem. The October 31, 1917, Battle of Beersheba is quite famous, and was the first part of the wider Third Battle of Gaza (October 31, 1917 – November 7, 1917), and opened the door for the December 9, 1917, capture of Jerusalem by Allenby's forces. The Battle of Beersheba is especially known for its cavalry charge.

Key Understanding #2: 'Ishmael' Allenby with Beersheba, Dan with Dan. A part of the picture of Ishmael being linked with Beersheba is that the key battle in the "freeing" of Jerusalem in 1917 by General Allenby, whose actions represented the Jews (and Arabs) spiritually as Ishmael's Seed, was the Battle of Beersheba.
