John 12:12-15 (KJV) On the next day <u>much people</u> that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,

13 <u>TOOK BRANCHES OF PALM TREES</u>, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord. 14 And Jesus, when he had found a young ass, sat thereon; as it is written,

15 Fear not, daughter of Sion: behold, thy King cometh, sitting on an ass's colt.



Revelation 7:9-10 (KJV) After this I beheld, and, lo, <u>a</u> <u>great multitude</u>, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, <u>AND PALMS IN THEIR HANDS</u>; 10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God which sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb.
