Key Understanding: The relationship between the palm branches of the Feast of Booths and the palm branches of Palm Sunday. The reason why the Lord ordained palm branches (and Palm Sunday) to be associated with the deliverance of the Jews from the Romans through the kingship of Jesus Christ was because palm branches were associated with the Feast of Booths and the deliverance of the Jews from Egyptian slavery by Moses.
