Review (from the Key Understanding of the previous Unsealing): There are varying time periods that serve as fulfillments of "a little season" in Revelation 6:11 for the true tribulation saints as well as for the paralleling great multitude counterfeit tribulation saints.

1. The time from the American Revolutionary War to the present serves as the <u>longer time period</u> of "a little season".

Key Understanding: *The winter soldiers*. The beginning of the *longer* time period of "a little season" was marked by Thomas Paine's <u>winter soldiers</u> of the Revolutionary War.

Thomas Paine's widely circulated pamphlet *Common Sense* was published in January 1776. In December 1776, Paine followed *Common Sense* with a series of pamphlets called *The Crisis*. The first of *The Crisis* pamphlets opened with perhaps Paine's most famous written words, *These are the times that try men's souls*.



These are the times that try men's souls. <u>The summer soldier</u> and the sunshine patriot will, in this crisis, shrink from the service of their country; but he that stands it now, deserves the love and thanks of man and woman. Tyranny, like hell, is not easily conquered; yet we have this consolation with us, that the harder the conflict, the more glorious the triumph.

Winter soldiers. Washington at Valley Forge during the winter of 1777-1778, a year after Thomas Paine wrote about "the summer soldier" in *The Crisis*.
