Key Understanding #1: *Watchman Nee's death*. Watchman Nee's death on May 30, 1972 (= June 10 = 6:10) was ordained to point to Revelation 6:9-11 (specifically 6:10, for May 30 + 11 days = 6:10) and the Fifth Seal's *tribulation* saints.

Revelation 6:9-11 (KJV) And when he had opened THE FIFTH SEAL, I saw under the altar the souls of THEM THAT WERE SLAIN for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: 10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, HOW LONG, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth?

11 And WHITE ROBES were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for A LITTLE SEASON, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

Key Understanding #2: How long, O Lord. The time, or watch, theme (thus pointing to Watchman Nee) is also seen in Revelation 6:10 (in addition to Revelation 6:11) through the words, How long, O Lord?
