
Revelation 6:9-11 (KJV) And when he had opened <u>THE FIFTH SEAL</u>, I saw under the altar **the souls of <u>THEM THAT WERE SLAIN for the word of God</u>**, and for the testimony which they held:

10 And they cried with a loud voice, saying, <u>HOW LONG</u>, <u>O Lord</u>, <u>holy and true</u>, <u>dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth</u>?

11 And <u>WHITE ROBES</u> were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for <u>A LITTLE SEASON</u>, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

Key Understanding: *The martyrdom of Watchman Nee.* The word *martyr* is often used of Watchman Nee. The theme of the *martyrdom* of Watchman Nee matches up with the theme of the fifth seal's *martyred saints*.
