Key Understanding: The 144,000 and the heavenly temple. The Lord's heavenly temple is closely associated with the "great multitude" in Revelation 7:15 – Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple – and is also associated with the 144,000 in Revelation 14:3, confirmed through the 144,000 singing a new song before the throne.

Revelation 14:1-3 (KJV) And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him AN HUNDRED FORTY AND FOUR THOUSAND, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. 2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:

3 And they sung as it were a new song
before the throne, and before the four
beasts, and the elders: and no man could
learn that song but THE HUNDRED
AND FORTY AND FOUR THOUSAND



<u>AND FORTY AND FOUR THOUSAND</u>, which were redeemed from the earth.

Revelation 7:9, 14-17 (KJV) After this I beheld, and, lo, <u>A</u> <u>GREAT MULTITUDE</u>, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, <u>AND PALMS IN THEIR HANDS</u>;

14 And I said unto him, Sir, thou knowest. And he said to me, THESE ARE THEY WHICH CAME OUT OF GREAT TRIBULATION, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

▶ 15 <u>Therefore are they before the throne of God</u>, <u>AND SERVE</u> <u>HIM DAY AND NIGHT IN HIS TEMPLE</u>: and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them.

16 They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat.

17 For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters: and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.
