Key Understanding: In the palm of the Lord's hand. The 144,000 "of all the tribes of the children of Israel" are engraved in the palms of the Lord's hands.

**Revelation 7:1-4 (KJV)** And after these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the earth, holding the four winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea,

3 Saying, Hurt not the earth, neither the sea, nor the trees, till we have sealed the servants of our God in their foreheads. 4 And I heard the number of them which were sealed: and there were sealed AN **HUNDRED AND FORTY AND FOUR** THOUSAND OF ALL THE TRIBES OF THE CHILDREN OF ISRAEL [which do not include the tribe of Dan].



**Isaiah 49:16.** A portion of Isaiah 49 is about the restoration of Israel, a matter which happens to match up with the themes surrounding Revelation 7:1-8. For example, it was shown in The Green Jews series (Unsealings #2526-#2540) that the birth of Israel on May 14-15, 1948, was connected with the passage of Revelation 7:1-8, but as a *counterfeit*. The body of Israelis that was birthed on May 14-15, 1948, is actually represented by the tribe of Dan.

Here are the verses of Isaiah 49:13-16:

**Isaiah 49:13-16 (KJV)** Sing, O heavens; and be joyful, O earth; and break forth into singing, O mountains: for the LORD hath comforted his people, and will have mercy upon his afflicted. 14 But Zion said, The LORD hath forsaken me, and my Lord hath forgotten me.

15 Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? yea, they may forget, yet will I not forget thee.

16 Behold, I HAVE GRAVEN THEE UPON THE PALMS OF MY HANDS; thy walls are continually before me.

**Isaiah 49:13-16 (NIV)** Shout for joy, O heavens; rejoice, O earth; burst into song, O mountains! For the LORD comforts his people and will have compassion on his afflicted ones. 14 But Zion said, "The LORD has forsaken me, the Lord has forgotten me."

15 "Can a mother forget the baby at her breast and have no compassion on the child she has borne? Though she may forget, I will not forget you!

16 See, <u>I HAVE ENGRAVED YOU ON THE PALMS OF MY HANDS</u>; your walls are ever before me.
